



Medicare Advantage shuts down the Medicare for-All argument

MN 57%

FL 43%

PA 41%

WI 40%

OH 39%

AZ 39%

MI 36%

NV 35%

In larger urban areas which are usually heavy BLUE such as Miami-Dade in Florida, the Medicare advantage enrollment is 66%.
