It's insane that we let people live here two decades and do nothing about it.

A lot of insurance agents are complaining that the lack of subsidies is killing their business. Totally understandable. My solution to the whole ACA mess: admit the ACA has failed, it doesn't work, premiums are sky-high, and \$10,000 deductibles are unmanageable. Then create a truly bipartisan commission—both sides have to agree, not like Obamacare, and solve the problem.

Latest "they'll deport anybody" freak-out: ICE supposedly deported a Native American woman. Turns out the Polk County Sheriff's Office mixed up their prisoners and confused her with a Mexican national. Had nothing to do with ICE.

Donald Trump has essentially excommunicated Marjorie Taylor Greene. She's gone off the deep end, and he says he'll endorse any primary challenger who runs against her.

People say "They've been fighting in the Middle East for thousands of years." The same is true in Europe. Compare a map of Europe from 1,000 years ago to today—they've been fighting forever. There's no difference.

Nut of the year: Claim that Trump is sending deportees to "Alligator Alcatraz"—dumping them in the Everglades so the alligators can eat them and dispose of millions of bodies. Cheaper than flying them home.

DHS update: 2.2 million illegal immigrants have either self-deported or been removed since January 20th. They expect to be close to 3 million by year-end.

Democrats accidentally figured out how to kill Obamacare: Trump wants to cut the insurance companies out entirely—and he's 100% right. Let individuals buy exactly the coverage they want, no mandated packages. Want chiropractic and acupuncture? Buy it. Just need hospital coverage? Buy that.
